Remember, the tone should be professional. 10 points</p>
<p>Comments are present throughout the draft.</p>	<p>Each part of the draft has comments. 10 comments in total. 15.0 pts</p>	<p>Only the beginning of the draft is commented on. 7-9 comments are present. 9.0 pts</p>	<p>4-6 comments are present. 6.0 pts</p>
